<sup>2</sup> The top vehicle out-of-service violation in North America was for brakes. Inspectors identified 3,304 out-of-service brake system violations, 24.4% of all vehicle out-of-service violations. In addition, the third most-cited (2,257) vehicle out-of-service violation was for 20% defective brakes, which is when 20% or more of the vehicle's (or combination of vehicles) brakes have an out-of-service condition. Combined, there were 5,561 brake-related out-of-service violations (brake systems and 20% defective brakes), accounting for 41.1% of out-of-service vehicle violations.
